

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving the Tohono O'odham Tribal Employment Rights Office FY - 2002 EEOC Budget)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 01-648**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has operated the Tribal Employment Rights Office since**  
2 **1978 and has successfully met the needs of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the funding for the Tohono O'odham Nation Tribal Employment Rights Office has been**  
4 **supplemented by the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission in the amount of**  
5 **\$25,000.00; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the continued operation of the Tribal Employment Rights Office is essential to**  
7 **eradicate employment discrimination within the exterior boundaries of the Tohono**  
8 **O'odham Nation; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the contract between the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission and the Tohono**  
10 **O'odham Tribal Employment Rights Office has been approved by the Office of the**  
11 **Chairman in the amount of \$25,000.00.**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council that it**  
13 **hereby approves the continued supplemental funding for the Tribal Employment**  
14 **Rights Office from the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission in the amount of**  
15 **\$25,000.00.**

16 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this grant shall commence on October 01, 2001**  
17 **through September 30, 2002.**

18 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono**  
19 **O'odham Nation's officials, to wit: the Chairman is authorized to negotiate and execute**  
20 **the grant, provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding, or funding**  
21 **levels of the grant shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.**

22 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 20<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
23 **of DECEMBER, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0-**  
24 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
25 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
26 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
27 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
28 **Stat. 984).**


