

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Budget Justification for the FY 2002 Bureau of Reclamation Fund Account 11-5015,**  
**Water Resources Study Program Continuation Under Public Law 93-638 Grant for**  
**a Comprehensive Water Inventory)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 01-654**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation (Nation) entered into a Grant Agreement with the United**  
2 **States Department of Interior, Bureau of Reclamation (BOR), Phoenix Area Office**  
3 **under the Indian Self Determination and Education Assistance Act, P.L. 93-638, for the**  
4 **purpose of conducting a comprehensive water inventory of the Nation, designated an**  
5 **Agreement No. 98-FG-32-00800 (Grant Agreement); and**

6 **WHEREAS, the term of the Grant Agreement has been extended for one (1) year beginning on**  
7 **October 1, 2001 and expiring on September 30, 2002 and Budget justification was**  
8 **authorized under Resolution No. 01-516; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Water Resources Study Program has proposed a budget amendment for fiscal year**  
10 **2002 in the amount of \$2,006,747.70; and**

11 **WHEREAS, this budget amendment has been reviewed by the Water Resources Committee and the**  
12 **Budget and Finance Committee and is recommended for approval by the Legislative**  
13 **Council.**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes the**  
15 **carryover of savings of Bureau of Reclamation funds provided by the P.L. 93-638**  
16 **Bureau of Reclamation Grant, for the Water Resources Study Program in the total**  
17 **amount of \$2,006,747.70.**

18 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the total budget amendment funding for fiscal year 2002 of**  
19 **\$2,006,747.70 for the Water Resources Study Program is approved in accordance with**  
20 **the budget attached hereto.**

22 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 20<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
23 **of DECEMBER, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0-**  
24 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
25 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
26 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
27 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
28 **Stat. 984).**
