9	WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved a match of \$52,923 by Resolution
10	No. 2000-045 and \$50,571.10 remains in the FY 2001 budget.
11	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the attached Land Use Program ANA grant and Tribal
12	Match budget to develop a Land Use Plan and to train tribal members and staff in land
13	use planning techniques is hereby approved by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
