

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving Amendment Number One to Lobbying Contract between the Tohono**  
**O'odham Nation and Ducheneaux, Taylor & Associates, Inc.)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 01-662**

1 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is vested with the power “[t]o consult, negotiate and conclude**  
2 **agreements and contracts on behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . with private**  
3 **persons” (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(f)); and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council recognizes the need for legislative and administrative**  
5 **advocacy concerning federal programs, services, and other federal activities affecting**  
6 **the Nation; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the firm of Ducheneaux, Taylor & Associates, Inc. is currently providing such services,**  
8 **including: advising the Nation regarding federal appropriations, legislation, and**  
9 **programs; acting as a liaison with the United States Executive and Legislative**  
10 **Branches; arranging meetings with federal officials; providing regular client**  
11 **memoranda on federal activities affecting the Nation; and**

12 **WHEREAS, on October 11, 2001, the Legislative Council did authorize the Nation's Chairman and**  
13 **Legislative Council Chairwoman to execute a three-month service agreement with**  
14 **Ducheneaux, Taylor & Associates, Inc. (“Ducheneaux Agreement”) that will expire**  
15 **December 31, 2001 (Resolution No. 01-539, approved October 18, 2001); and**

16 **WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend and thereby extend the existing Ducheneaux Agreement to**  
17 **cover the entire FY 2002 period.**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Chairman**  
19 **of the Tohono O'odham Nation and the Chairwoman of the Legislative Council are**  
20 **hereby authorized to execute the attached “Amendment Number One to Service**  
21 **Agreement” between the Nation and Ducheneaux, Taylor & Associates, Inc.**  
22 **(“Amendment”).**

23 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the attached Amendment shall extend the existing Ducheneaux**  
24 **Agreement's termination date from December 31, 2001 to September 30, 2002, thereby**  
25 **making the Agreement effective for the period from October 1, 2001 through**  
26 **September 30, 2002.**

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1 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Amendment shall also authorize the payment of fees, costs, and  
2 expenses for the period from October 1, 2001 to September 30, 2002 as described in the  
3 Amendment, provided that the Amendment's total cost, including any amounts paid  
4 pursuant to the Ducheneaux Agreement authorized by Resolution No. 01-539, shall  
5 not exceed \$70,000.

6 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 21<sup>ST</sup> Day  
7 of DECEMBER, 2001 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,528.9 FOR; 721.3  
8 AGAINST; 167.3 NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by  
9 Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono  
10 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
11 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48  
12 Stat. 984).
