

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Delegating Authority to Trust Reform Task Force Delegation)

RESOLUTION NO. 02-011

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to consult with (1)**
2 **appropriate federal agencies regarding federal activities that affect the Tohono**
3 **O'odham Nation and (2) other Indian tribes on all matters within the Council's**
4 **authority (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(j) and (f));**
5 **and**

6 **WHEREAS, as a result of tribal leaders' discussions at the NCAI 2001 Annual Session, the**
7 **December 12, 2001 Tribal Leaders' Caucus in Albuquerque, NM, and subsequent**
8 **"consultation" meetings with the Department of the Interior ("DOI"), the DOI has**
9 **agreed to the creation of a tribal Trust Reform Task Force to participate in and guide**
10 **trust reform; and**

11 **WHEREAS, a meeting of Arizona, Nevada, and Utah tribes is scheduled for January 10, 2002, in**
12 **part, to appoint Western Regional representatives to the Trust Reform Task Force;**
13 **and**

14 **WHEREAS, it is in the Nation's best interest to delegate authority to certain officials to represent**
15 **the Nation's position on the Trust Reform Task Force and to act on the Nation's behalf**
16 **at the January 10, 2002 meeting and future Trust Reform Task Force meetings.**

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the following officials of the Tohono O'odham**
18 **Nation are hereby delegated authority to represent the Nation's reorganization**
19 **position, to vote, and otherwise act on the Nation's behalf at the January 10, 2002**
20 **Western Regional meeting in Las Vegas, NV and future Trust Reform Task Force**
21 **meetings:**

- 23 **2. Legislative Council Chairwoman Rita Martinez**
- 24 **3. Councilperson Evelyn B. Juan Manuel**

26 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation hereby urges that Chairman**
27 **Edward D. Manuel be selected as a Western Region representative to the Trust Reform**
28 **Task Force.**

6 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
7 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


