

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Authorizing the expenditure of \$15,000.00 in support of the Tohono O'odham**  
**Citizenship Campaign)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 02-012**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorized the Executive to pursue federal**  
2 **legislation which would make all Tohono O'odham enrolled members U.S. citizens**  
3 **and recognize the Nation's enrollment credential as the legal equivalent of a state-**  
4 **issued birth certificate; and**

5 **WHEREAS, Representative Ed Pastor introduced the Tohono O'odham Citizenship Act of 2001 on**  
6 **June 27, 2001; and**

7 **WHEREAS, one hundred eighteen (118) members of the U.S. House of Representatives have**  
8 **joined as cosponsors of the Tohono O'odham Citizenship Act of 2001; and**

9 **WHEREAS, twelve (12) of Arizona's fifteen (15) County Boards of Supervisors have passed**  
10 **resolutions in support of the Tohono O'odham Citizenship Act of 2001 by unanimous**  
11 **votes; and**

12 **WHEREAS, twenty-one (21) tribal governments in Arizona have passed resolutions in support of**  
13 **the Tohono O'odham Citizenship Act of 2001; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Executive estimates that several more months of the Citizenship Campaign are**  
15 **required in Washington, D.C.; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Citizenship Campaign has received a \$15,000.00 contribution**  
17 **from the Desert Diamond Casino to help pay the costs associated with the Citizenship**  
18 **Campaign.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that:**

20 **1. Executive is authorized to expend the \$15,000.00 for the following purposes:**

21 **(1) \$12,300.00 - Three (3) months rent at 2520 Woodley Road, N.W., Washington,**  
22 **D.C. residence/Campaign Headquarters,**  
23 **(\$4,100.00 per month X 3 months = \$12,300.00).**

24 **(2) \$2,700.00 living and Campaign expenses (food, subway fees, xeroxing,**  
25 **printing, binding, mailing, furniture rental).**

26 **TOTAL - \$15,000.00**

27 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 09<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
28 **of JANUARY 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,753.75 FOR; -0-**  
29 **AGAINST; 663.75 NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**






