6		2001 through December 31, 2001; and					
7	WHEREAS,	the Attorney Contract expired on December 31, 2001; and					
8	WHEREAS,	continued representation is necessary to protect the Nation's interests in these					
9		proceedings; and					
10	WHEREAS,	the Attorney General has proposed Amendment No. 1 to the Attorney Contract which					
11		increases the Contract amount to \$66,000 and extends its term through September					
12		30, 2002; and					
13	WHEREAS,	the Operating Budget for the Office of Attorney General for Fiscal Year 2002, as					
14		approved by the Legislative Council in Resolution No. 01-629, includes sufficient					
15		funds for Amendment No. 1; and					
16	WHEREAS,	the Domestic Affairs Committee recommends approval by the Legislative Council of					
17		Amendment No. 1 to the Attorney Contract.					
18	NOW THERI	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:					
19		1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves Amendment No. 1 to					
20		the Attorney Contract with California Indian Legal Services, in the form attached					
21		hereto, which increases the Contract amount to \$66,000 and extends the term					
22		through September 30, 2002.					
23		2. Funding for Amendment No. 1 in Fiscal Year 2002 shall be provided from the					
24		Operating Budget for the Office of Attorney General.
