

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Amendment No. 1 to Attorney Contract with Quigley & Whitehill, P.L.C.)**

RESOLUTION NO. 02-018

1 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Legislative Council Resolution 01-535, the Nation entered into an**
2 **Attorney Contract with Quigley & Whitehill, P.L.C. for the purpose of providing legal**
3 **representation to the Nation in connection with negotiations to amend the Nation's**
4 **gaming compact with the State of Arizona; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Attorney Contract was in the amount of \$50,000 for the period from October 1,**
6 **2001 through December 31, 2001; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Attorney Contract expired on December 31, 2001; and**

8 **WHEREAS, continued representation is necessary to protect the Nation's interests in these**
9 **matters; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Attorney General has proposed Amendment No. 1 to the Attorney Contract which**
11 **increases the Contract amount to \$172,462 and extends its term through September**
12 **30, 2002; and**

13 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 01-630, the Legislative Council reauthorized \$172,462 and**
14 **allocated such amount to the Gaming Litigation Account (No. 01-4236) for expenditure**
15 **in Fiscal Year 2002; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Gaming Litigation Account includes sufficient funds for Amendment No. 1; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee recommends approval by the Legislative Council of**
18 **Amendment No. 1 to the Attorney Contract.**

19 **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

- 20 **1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves Amendment No. 1 to**
21 **the Attorney Contract with Quigley & Whitehill, P.L.C., in the form attached**
22 **hereto, which increases the Contract amount to \$172,462 and extends the term**
23 **through September 30, 2002.**
- 24 **2. Funding for Amendment No. 1 in Fiscal Year 2002 shall be provided from the**
25 **Gaming Litigation Account (No. 01-4236).**
- 26 **3. The Chairman of the Nation is authorized and directed to execute Amendment**
27 **No. 1.**

28 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10TH Day**
29 **of JANUARY 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,273.0 FOR; -0-**
30 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 144.5 [10] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
31 **Section 2 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**

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Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


