13	WHEREAS,	pursuant to Resolution 01-630, the Legislative Council reauthorized \$172,462 and
14		allocated such amount to the Gaming Litigation Account (No. 01-4236) for expenditure
15		in Fiscal Year 2002; and
16	WHEREAS,	the Gaming Litigation Account includes sufficient funds for Amendment No. 1; and
17	WHEREAS,	the Domestic Affairs Committee recommends approval by the Legislative Council of
18		Amendment No. 1 to the Attorney Contract.
