	Authority as an enterprise of the Nation, authorized to establish, operate and
	maintain a skilled nursing care facility for all persons with admission preference
	granted to members of the Tohono O'odham Nation, and to provide employment
	opportunities for members of the Nation, all in accordance with applicable standards
	and requirements of licensing, accrediting and funding agencies.
