

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Amending Resolution No. 01-490, "Approval and Acceptance of the Application for
the Superfund CORE Grant and Approval for Expenditure of Attached Budget")**

RESOLUTION NO. 02-032

1 **WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 01-490, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council accepted \$75,000**
2 **in new funding for the continuation of the Superfund CORE Pilot Project Program; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Superfund CORE project period extends from October 01, 2001 through September**
4 **30, 2002; and**

5 **WHEREAS, after this award was approved the TONEPA was informed that the budget needed to be**
6 **tracked separately, \$50,000 for CORE and \$25,000 for PA/SI; and**

7 **WHEREAS, a new account number needs to be established for PA/SI; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Resolution No. 01-490, stated that FY 2001 base salaries will be utilized; and**

9 **WHEREAS, subsequently, the Nation has decided to allow the programs to implement the Valliant**
10 **compensation study recommendations subject to a twenty percent (20%) cap; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the program is adding three new line items: 750 Capital Equipment, 771-Repair &**
12 **Maintenance-Vehicle and 893 Non-major Office Equipment.**

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby amends**
14 **Resolution No. 01-490 in the following manner:**

- 15 **1. The Superfund Budget of \$75,000 shall be split \$50,000 for CORE and \$25,000 for**
16 **PA/SI and a new account shall be established for PA/SI; and**
- 17 **2. Authorizing the TONEPA to expend all available funds awarded pursuant to**
18 **Cooperative Agreement #V-97906202 beginning October 01, 2001; and**
- 19 **3. Authorizing the TONEPA to use the Valliant compensation study**
20 **recommendations subject to a twenty percent (20%) cap in its FY 2002 budget**
21 **calculations; and**
- 22 **4. Line items 750 Capital Equipment, 771-Repair & Maintenance-Vehicle and 893**
23 **Non-major Office Equipment are included into the Superfund CORE and PA/SI**
24 **budgets.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11TH Day**
26 **of JANUARY, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,579.25 FOR; 677.55**
27 **AGAINST; 160.7 NOT VOTING; and [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
28 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
29 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
30 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
31 **Stat. 984).**
