2 **Sampling Grant Project (Assistance Amendment #E-98981201-01); and**


3 **WHEREAS, the program period has been modified to November 01, 2000 through July 01, 2002.**

5 **Assistance Amendment #E-98981201-01 extending the Soil and Groundwater Sampling**  
6 **Project period to November 01, 2000 through July 01, 2002.**

7 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the TONEPA is authorized to expend all available funds awarded**  
8 **pursuant to Assistance Amendment #E-98981201-01.**

9 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
10 **of JANUARY, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,485.1 FOR; 416.1**  
11 **AGAINST; 516.3 NOT VOTING; and [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
12 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
13 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
14 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
15 **Stat. 984).**

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


