

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Amendment No. 1 to Attorney Contract with Yoder Law Offices, P.C.)**

RESOLUTION NO. 02-051

1 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Legislative Council Resolution 01-595, the Nation entered into an**
2 **Attorney Contract with the Yoder Law Offices, P.C. (the "Attorney") for the purpose of**
3 **providing legal representation to the Nation in connection with the administration**
4 **of the Nation's 401(k) pension plan; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Attorney Contract was in the amount of \$4,000.00 for the period from October 01,**
6 **2001 through December 31, 2001; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Attorney Contract expired on December 31, 2001; and**

8 **WHEREAS, continued representation is necessary to protect the Nation's interests in these**
9 **matters; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Attorney General and the Human Resources Office have proposed Amendment No.**
11 **1 to the Attorney Contract which increases the Contract amount to \$5,000.00,**
12 **substitutes Account No. 01-3036-810 for Account No. 1-1006-615 as the funding source**
13 **for the Contract, acknowledges the new name of the Attorney's law firm and extends**
14 **the Contract term through September 30, 2002; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee and Human Resources Development Committee**
16 **recommend approval by the Legislative Council of Amendment No. 1 to the Attorney**
17 **Contact.**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

- 19 **1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves Amendment No. 1 to**
20 **the Attorney Contract with the Yoder Law Offices, P.C., in the form attached**
21 **hereto, which increases the Contract amount to \$5,000, extends the term through**
22 **September 30, 2002 and acknowledges the new name of the Attorney's law firm.**
- 23 **2. Funding for Amendment No. 1 in Fiscal Year 2002 shall be provided from the**
24 **General Support Services Administrative Provision - 401(k) Trustees Account (No.**
25 **01-3036-810).**
- 26 **3. The Chairman of the Nation is authorized and directed to execute Amendment**
27 **No. 1.**


