

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approval of FY 2003 Title VI, Part C Native American Family Caregiver Support**  
**Program - Grant Proposal)**

RESOLUTION NO. 02-053

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has successfully operated a program for the elderly**  
2 **members of the Nation; and**

3 **WHEREAS, funding for Title VI, Part C Native American Family Caregiver Support Program has**  
4 **been made possible in part by Title VI of the Older American's Act of 1978, as**  
5 **amended; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Elderly Program is requesting approval of the Title VI, Part C Native American**  
7 **Family Caregiver Support budget proposal in the amount of \$35,000; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Elderly Program will benefit elder members of the Tohono O'odham Nation by**  
9 **providing Outreach Services both at the congregate centers and through home visits**  
10 **providing caregiver information to elders; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Native American Family Caregiver Support funding will also be used to provide**  
12 **Information and Referral services to the Nation's elders.**

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative that it hereby approves:**

- 14           **1. The project proposal from April 01, 2002 to March 31, 2005.**
- 15           **2. The first year budget of \$35,000.00, which shall commence on April 01, 2002 and**  
16 **end March 31, 2003.**
- 17           **3. The Tohono O'odham Nation officials, to wit: The Chairman and Vice-Chairman**  
18 **or designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant,**  
19 **and expend such funds per attached budget. Provided however, that any**  
20 **amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of this contract shall be**  
21 **submitted for further prior approval by this Council.**

23 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 07<sup>TH</sup>, Day**  
24 **of FEBRUARY, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,250.2 FOR; -0-**  
25 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 167.3 [08] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
26 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
27 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
28 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
29 **Stat. 984).**
