

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving a Mutual Protection and Law Enforcement Agreement with Maricopa County)**

RESOLUTION NO. 02-061

1 WHEREAS, in April 1998 the Tohono O'odham Nation entered into a law enforcement mutual aid  
2 agreement with Maricopa County to address the law enforcement needs of San Lucy  
3 Village in Maricopa County; and

4 WHEREAS, that agreement terminated in June 2001 when its three year term expired; and

5 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Police Department continues to need a mutual aid  
6 arrangement with the Maricopa County Sheriff's Department in order to adequately  
7 respond to calls from San Lucy Village; and

8 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation and San Lucy District wish to renew the Mutual  
9 Protection and Law Enforcement Agreement with Maricopa County for a five (5) year  
10 term; and

11 WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee has reviewed this Agreement and recommends  
12 approval.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council:

- 14 1. Approves the Mutual Protection and Law Enforcement Agreement with Maricopa  
15 County substantially in the form attached hereto; and
- 16 2. Authorizes the Chairman of the Nation to sign the Agreement on behalf of the  
17 Nation.


18 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 07<sup>th</sup> Day  
19 of FEBRUARY, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0-  
20 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by  
21 Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono  
22 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
23 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48  
24 Stat. 984).


