

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Support for an amendment to Gu Achi District's FY-2002 budget to create a Temporary Officer Support Worker position)

RESOLUTION NO. 02-065

1 **WHEREAS, the Gu Achi District Council has submitted a budget amendment to the Legislative**
2 **Council for support of a Temporary Office Support Worker for their district; and**
3 **WHEREAS, the Gu Achi District Council does have sufficient funds available from the Vice Chair's**
4 **salary, which is now vacant to cover this position; and**
5 **WHEREAS, the amount needed to cover the cost of this new position for the remainder of the FY-**
6 **2002 is as follows:**

7	Temporary Office Support Worker	\$12,282.20
8	Fringe Benefits	<u>1,696.60</u>
9	Total	\$13,978.80

10 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves**
11 **the budget amendment made by the Gu Achi District Council from their FY-2002**
12 **budget to cover a new Temporary Office Support Worker for Gu Achi District.**

13 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH Day**
14 **of FEBRUARY, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,904.8 FOR; -0-**
15 **AGAINST; 160.7 NOT VOTING; and 352.0 [12] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**
16 **by Section 1 (d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by**
17 **the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
18 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
19 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


