

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Change in Consent to Grant of Easement Form for Water Delivery
Pipeline to be Constructed in San Xavier District)

RESOLUTION NO. 02-066

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council passed Resolution No. 01-663 on December**
2 **20, 2001; and**

3 **WHEREAS, this resolution supported granting an easement to the San Xavier District to**
4 **construct, on tribal trust land, a water delivery pipeline (the AWPf pipeline) that**
5 **would carry CAP water from the CAP Link to a riparian restoration site on the west**
6 **bank of the San Cruz River; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the consent of easement form approved by the Legislative Council on December 20,**
8 **2001, established the size of the AWPf pipeline at six inches (6") and specified its use**
9 **as a water delivery for the riparian restoration site; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the San Xavier Cooperative Farm is currently planning its Rehabilitation and**
11 **Extension, including the development of several fields on the east side of Interstate**
12 **19, adjacent to the proposed alignment for the AWPf pipeline; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the AWPf pipeline presents an opportunity to carry water to these fields; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the AWPf pipeline diameter will need to be increased from six inches (6") to twelve**
15 **inches (12") to allow for water delivery to the future farm fields and the riparian**
16 **restoration site; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the Bureau of Reclamation supports this proposed increase in pipeline size and will**
18 **assist in funding construction of the larger pipeline.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council consents to**
20 **amending the Grant of Easement form referenced above to allow a pipeline of 12"**
21 **to be constructed, and to allow expanding the use of this pipeline to include water**
22 **delivery to farm fields as well as the riparian restoration site, and authorizes the**
23 **Chairman of the Nation to sign the amended Consent to Grant of Easement form**
24 **attached to this resolution on behalf of the Nation.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH Day**
27 **of FEBRUARY, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,877.2 FOR; 188.3**
28 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 352.0 [13] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
29 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
30 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
31 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
32 **Stat. 984).**




