

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(In Support of Higher Education Services FY-2002, Budget Modification #1
Account 10-1215)

RESOLUTION NO. 02-069

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation through the Higher Education Services program has
2 been successfully providing counseling and financial assistance to eligible Tohono
3 O'odham to attend Post Secondary Institutes; and


4 WHEREAS, the Higher Education Services has savings from Fiscal year 2001 in the amount of
5 \$197,782.89, which was identified by the Grants & Contracts Office; and

6 WHEREAS, the FY-2002 Higher Education Services modification also reflects reducing line items
7 to move to line item 626 (Allowances and Stipend) to cover costs for continued
8 services.

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council supports the
10 Higher Education Services budget modification #1 reflecting the FY-2001 savings in
11 the amount of \$197,782.89, with the total budget to \$912,162.17.

12 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH Day
13 of FEBRUARY, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,746.3 FOR; -0-
14 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 671.2 [14] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
15 Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
16 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
17 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
18 Stat. 984).


