

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Amending Resolution No. 01-661, "Authorization and Appropriation of Supplemental Funding for '93 ICDBG, '94 ICDBG, '94 HOME, '95 ICDBG, '96 HOME, '97 ICDBG and the Colonias (EPA/USDA/TON) Grants from the Desert Diamond Savings Account from the Gaming Revenues," to Adopt FY 2002 Housing Supplemental Appropriation Budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 02-070

1 **WHEREAS, Article VI, Section I(d)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the**
2 **Legislative Council with the fiscal power to appropriate funds provided that "[a]ll**
3 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets**
4 **authorized under resolutions or in accordance with ordinances of the Tohono**
5 **O'odham Council"; and**

6 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 01-661, the Legislative Council did appropriate and**
7 **authorize a total expenditure of \$9,405,649.93 ("Housing Supplemental**
8 **Appropriation") over a three-year period to complete a number of housing projects**
9 **that had previously lacked sufficient funding; and**

10 **WHEREAS, although the Legislative Budget and Finance and Housing Committees did review and**
11 **recommend the approval of FY 2002, 2003, and 2004 budgets for the Housing**
12 **Supplemental Appropriation, these budgets were not expressly approved or adopted**
13 **with the passage of Resolution No. 01-661; and**

14 **WHEREAS, in order to ensure proper oversight of and accounting for Housing Supplemental**
15 **Appropriation funds, it is in the Nation's best interest for the Legislative Council to**
16 **amend Resolution No. 01-661 by expressly adopting the attached FY 2002 Planning**
17 **Department - Housing Rehabilitation Project Budget, which has been reviewed and**
18 **approved by the Legislative Housing and Budget and Finance Committees.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby amends**
20 **Resolution No. 01-661 to adopt the attached FY 2002 Planning Department - Housing**
21 **Rehabilitation Project Budget in the amount of \$2,628,609.87.**

22 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the attached FY 2002**
23 **Planning Department - Housing Rehabilitation Project Budget shall be effective**
24 **retroactive to January 1, 2002.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH. Day**
26 **of FEBRUARY, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,702.5FOR; -0-**
27 **AGAINST; 188.3 NOT VOTING; and 526.7 [13] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**
28 **by Section 1 (d) (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
29 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
30 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
31 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


