

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Authorizing the Economic Development Department to Develop Organization and
Operating Plans for Delivering Services to O'odham Living in Mexico)

DEFEATED
RESOLUTION NO. 02-080

1 **WHEREAS, Initiative IN-01-97 authorized certain economic development programs, including**
2 **the Business Grant Program, business education activities, support for individual**
3 **business owners, and economic development planning; and**

4 **WHEREAS, members of the Tohono O'odham Nation living in Mexico have expressed their desire**
5 **to participate in and benefit from these program activities; and**

6 **WHEREAS, Legislative Council, by means of Resolutions 2000-150, 2000-447, and 02-029 approved**
7 **and funded economic development services for the O'odham in Mexico; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Economic Development Department and the Nation's Attorney General have**
9 **discussed problems, issues and strategies associated with program implementation**
10 **and service delivery; and**

11 **WHEREAS, they found that program benefits may be provided to O'odham in Mexico more**
12 **effectively and more efficiently through a non-profit entity incorporated under**
13 **Mexican law.**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation that**
15 **the Economic Development Department is directed to develop a plan to deliver**
16 **economic development services through a non-profit Mexican Civil Association.**

17 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the plan will discuss alternative organization structures,**
18 **operating plans, funding mechanisms, control and reporting responsibilities, and**
19 **will make implementation recommendations.**

20 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the budget approved by the Legislative Council for the activities**
21 **of the Economic Development Department in Mexico (account #24-1813) would be**
22 **used to support these activities.**

23 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Council authorizes the Chairman of the Tohono O'odham**
24 **Nation to enter into contracts and agreements in support of these activities.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was presented to the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 05TH.**
27 **Day of MARCH, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present, and by a vote of 1,068.55 FOR;**
28 **1,204.45 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 144.5 [06] ABSENT, failed to pass because it did not receive**
29 **a majority of the votes cast as required by Section 2 of Article V of the Constitution of the Tohono**
30 **O'odham Nation.**


