

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Adopting the Election Board's Initiative Budget Supplemental Request in the
Amount of \$73,122.11)**

RESOLUTION NO. 02-095

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Election Board has received two applications for initiatives and**
2 **has prepared petitions for circulation; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Election Board has received inquiries about a third initiative;**
4 **and**

5 **WHEREAS, Article XV of the Tohono O'odham Constitution requires a national election within**
6 **ninety (90) days in the event that a valid petition is submitted and the Legislative**
7 **Council calls a special election; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Election Board did prepare and present an FY 2002 supplemental funding request**
9 **("Supplemental Request") which is attached to this resolution; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Rules Committee and the Executive Office of the Chairman**
11 **recommend approval of this Supplemental Request in the amount of \$73,122.11.**


12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the attached**
13 **initiative Supplemental Request is hereby approved and the Election Board is hereby**
14 **authorized to expend \$73,122.11 according to the attached budget.**

15 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the funds requested, \$73,122.11, be appropriated from the Mining**
16 **and Chemical Fund, Account No. 1067513.**

17 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that any balance of these funds that remains unexpended at the end of**
18 **FY 2002 shall revert back to the Mining and Chemical Fund.**

19 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06TH Day**
20 **of MARCH, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,501.0 FOR; 916.5**
21 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
22 **Section 1 (d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
23 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
24 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
25 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**




