(Approval of the Tohono O'odham Nation Employment & Training - Department of Labor - Supplemental Youth Services PY 2000 Budget Modification #3)

RESOLUTION NO. 02-100

1 WHEREAS, the Employment & Training, Department of Labor - Supplemental Youth Services PY
2 2000 Budget Modification #3 creates the line items to cover program expenses; and

3 WHEREAS, program expenses were moved from the SYS PY 1999 budget to this budget; and


4 WHEREAS, the funding amount for the Department of Labor Supplemental Youth Services
5 Budget Program Year 2000 is \$149,675.00.

6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby
7 approve the Department of Labor - Supplemental Youth Services Program Year 2000
8 Budget Modification #3 in the amount of \$149,675.00.

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
10 Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute
11 the contract, provided however, that any amendment affecting the funding or
12 funding levels of this contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this
13 Council.

14 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 07TH. Day
15 of MARCH, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,232.8 FOR; -0-
16 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 184.7 [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
17 Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
18 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
19 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
20 Stat. 984).


