

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving a Mutual Protection and Law Enforcement Agreement with Pinal County)

RESOLUTION NO. 02-107

1 WHEREAS, in September 1995 the Tohono O'odham Nation entered into a law enforcement
2 mutual aid agreement with Pinal County to address the law enforcement needs of
3 Florence Village in Pinal County; and

4 WHEREAS, that agreement terminated in September 1998 when its three year term expired; and

5 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Police Department continues to need a mutual aid
6 arrangement with the Pinal County Sheriff's Department in order to adequately
7 respond to calls from Florence Village; and

8 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation and GuAchi District wish to renew the Mutual Protection
9 and Law Enforcement Agreement with Pinal County for a five (5) year term; and

10 WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee has reviewed this Agreement and recommends
11 approval.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council:

- 13 1. Approves the Mutual Protection and Law Enforcement Agreement with Pinal
14 County substantially in the form attached hereto; and
- 15 2. Authorizes the Chairman of the Nation to sign the Agreement on behalf of the
16 Nation.

17 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH Day
18 of MARCH, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,229.2 FOR; -0-
19 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 188.3 [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
20 Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
21 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
22 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
23 Stat. 984).




