12		Hearing Rules provide otherwise (Rejection Hearing Rules, Section 6 and

14	WHEREAS,	"All Legislative Representatives and the Officers of the Legislative [Council] are
15		required to be present at all the Sessions unless otherwise excused."(Legislative
16		Rules, Article II, Section 1.A.1.); and
17	WHEREAS,	any Legislative Representative who is unable to attend a Council session is required
18		to give notice to the Legislative Secretary (Legislative Rules, Article II, Sections 1.A.2,
19		3.2); ,and
20	WHEREAS,	${\bf a}\ Legislative\ Representative\ shall\ be\ assessed\ a\ fine\ equal\ to\ one\ full\ day's\ pay,\ which$
21		shall be withheld from his or her salary; and
22	WHEREAS,	the following Legislative Council Representatives failed to provide adequate notice
23		of or adequate reasons for being tardy or absent during the March 11, 2002 rejections
24		hearings, despite the fact that the Legislative Council recessed the hearings until 1:00
25		p.m. to await the absent Representatives' arrival: Councilman David Garcia;
26		Councilperson Patti Cruz; Councilman Emilio Lewis; and Councilman Tony Burrell;

28	WHEREAS,	the Legislative Council received notice of the rejection hearing dates when the
29		Council set the hearings by Legislative Order No. 02-025 on January 10, 2002; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby fines the following Legislative Council Representatives an amount equal to one full day's pay, which shall be withheld from their salaries for their tardiness at or absence from the March 11, 2002 rejection hearings: Councilman David Garcia; Councilperson Patti Cruz; Councilman Emilio Lewis; and Councilman Tony Burrell.
