


RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Rescinding Resolution No. 02-123)

RESOLUTION NO. 02-125

1 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council set aside a Special Session on March 13, 2002 to address the
2 Appropriations Proposals of the Nation; and
3 WHEREAS, numerous questions arose regarding the review of oversight committees for the
4 various appropriation proposals; and
5 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council passed untitled Resolution No. 02-123 which addressed the FY
6 2004 Appropriation Proposal for the Adult and Juvenile Corrections Center Project;
7 and
8 WHEREAS, the Appropriations Committee requested to table all the proposals and require
9 oversight review; and
10 WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Nation that Resolution No. 02-123 be rescinded.
11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council hereby rescinds
12 Resolution No. 02-123.

13 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13TH Day
14 of MARCH, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0-
15 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
16 Section 1 (I) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
17 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
18 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
19 Stat. 984).
