

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Holding April 5, 2002 General Session at Indian Oasis Middle School to Address
Public Forum Issues)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 02-127

1 **WHEREAS, on March 22, 2002, the Legislative Council Rules Committee did receive a letter from**
2 **San Lucy District Chairwoman Ernestine Marquez, who, on behalf of the Tohono**
3 **O'odham Nation District Chairpersons, requested that the Legislative Council hold**
4 **a public forum; and**

5 **WHEREAS, seven Tohono O'odham Nation District Councils have passed resolutions supporting**
6 **the public forum request; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham District Chairpersons and seven District Councils are**
8 **requesting a public forum in response to concerns raised by the Nation's members**
9 **regarding the following issues:**

- 10 **I. Financial Status: (A) Tohono O'odham Nation**
11 **(B) Per Capita Distribution**
12 **(C) Salary Wage Increase**
13 **(D) VISA Project**
14 **(E) Gaming Revenues/Savings**

16 **II. Pending Projects: (A) Nursing Home Facility**
17 **(B) Westside Health Center**
18 **(C) Dialysis Center**

22 **WHEREAS, it has been requested that a public forum addressing these issues be held at the**
23 **Indian Oasis Intermediate Middle School on April 5, 2002; and**

24 **WHEREAS, according to the Legislative Rules, Article I, Section 2.C, "PLACE," Subsection 1.B, "A**
25 **majority of all the Legislative Representatives may agree to hold a Session in some**
26 **location other than the Chambers located at Sells. Such agreement may be by written**
27 **petition or by motion at any Legislative Session of the Legislative Council."**

28 **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**
29 **agrees to hold the April 5, 2002 General Session at the Indian Oasis Intermediate**

Middle School for the purpose of holding a public forum to address the above-identified issues, which shall be the only items on the agenda.


BE IT FINALLY ORDERED that the Legislative Council's April General Session agenda shall be amended as necessary to accommodate the public forum.

The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 01ST Day of APRIL 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,699.7 FOR; 602.45 AGAINST; 115.35 NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
