9	WHEREAS,	the current Juvenile Correctional facility faces the same problem as it too is over
10		crowded and is in need of program space to treat youthful drug and alcohol related
11		offenders; and
12	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation seeks to provide its members and community with
13		protection from harm and to provide a safe, secure and humane environment for
14		those awaiting trial and those who are serving a jail sentencing.
15	WHEREAS,	the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation supports the goal to provide
16		treatment and healing programs for those who are serving a jail sentence.
17	NOW, THE	REFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation
18		supports the Corrections Facility Project Group which is a partnership between the
19		Executive and Judicial Branches of the Tohono O'odham Nation government to
20		jointly plan, implement, and operate a modern Corrections facility capable of
21		appropriately serving the unique needs of both juveniles and adults in an effort to
22		reduce cost by sharing support facilities infrastructure.
