

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Higher Education Services Program FY 2004 Appropriations Request)

RESOLUTION NO. 02-146

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation, through the Higher Education services program has**
2 **been successfully providing counseling and financial assistance to eligible Tohono**
3 **O'odham to attend Post-Secondary Institutions; and**

4 **WHEREAS, a major Tohono O'odham Nation priority is to provide quality academic education**
5 **to increase the number of Tohono O'odham professionals; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the basic budget for Higher Education Services Program is at \$718,433.00 for this**
7 **year. However, the amount is inadequate to meet the demands of the population we**
8 **service; and**


9 **WHEREAS, the number of applications has steadily increased while the staff of one Education**
10 **Assistant Specialist under the Higher Education Services Program budget has**
11 **remained the same; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Education Department has submitted an appropriation**
13 **request to expand services provided under the existing Higher Education Services**
14 **Program in the amount of \$1,263,783.66.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that it does**
16 **hereby urgently request that Congress increase its appropriations for the Higher**
17 **Education Services Program in the amount of \$1,263,783.66 for the Tohono O'odham**
18 **Nation and that the appropriate officers of the Nation are hereby authorized and**
19 **directed to bring this request to the appropriate members and committees of**
20 **Congress.**

21 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 01st Day**
22 **of APRIL, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
23 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of**
24 **Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**
25 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
26 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


