

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Support of the Tohono O'odham Nation Veterans Memorial and Park)**

RESOLUTION NO. 02-151

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham men and women have served in all branches of the armed force**
2 **in peace time and in combat dating back to World War I to the current Afghanistan**
3 **War; and**

4 **WHEREAS, American Indians have served in the Armed Forces of the United States at a higher per**
5 **capita rate than any other minority ethnic; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the late Chairman Josiah Moore of the Tohono O'odham Nation had granted the**
7 **Veterans an area to build a Veterans Memorial Park; and**

8 **WHEREAS, there is a need for a Veterans Memorial Monument to honor all who made the**
9 **Supreme Sacrifice; and**

10 **WHEREAS, there is a need for a new Veterans Memorial Park where the Veterans Memorial**
11 **Monument can be placed; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the United States Air Force has informed the Tohono O'odham Nation that they will**
13 **contribute several military replicas for the Tohono O'odham Veteran Memorial Park,**
14 **F-15 jet plan, M-60 tank, 105 howitzer and military personnel carrier; and**

15 **WHEREAS, there is a lack of funds to build the Veterans Memorial Monument and Park.**

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby calls**
17 **upon Congress and the White House to set appropriate funding in the amount of**
18 **\$121,223.00 for the Veterans Memorial Monument and Park funding.**

19 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Appropriations Committee is hereby authorized and directed**
20 **to bring this request to the appropriate Agencies, Members and Committees of**
21 **Congress.**

22 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 01st Day**
23 **of APRIL, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,232.8 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
24 **-0- NOT VOTING; and 184.7[04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section**
25 **1 (j) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
26 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
27 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
28 **Stat. 984).**


