

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY 2004 Federal Appropriations Request for the Native American Housing Assistance
and Self-Determination Act, NAHASDA)**

RESOLUTION NO. 02-153

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has a land base of approximately 3 million acres with a
2 population of 24,200 members; and

3 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Ki:Ki Association (TOKA) currently manages a total of 1,122
4 homeownerships and rental units; and

5 WHEREAS, the Ki:Ki Association has identified the need for new home construction and complete
6 rehabilitation due to the substandard conditions on housing here on the Nation that
7 far exceeds the current available funding of \$6.7 million dollars under NAHASDA; and

8 WHEREAS, the Act provides for Indian Tribes the right to exercise Indian self-determination and
9 self-governance but fails to provide adequate federal funding; and

10 WHEREAS, the President's proposed funding for Year 2004 is not enough to fulfill the obligations
11 in providing the housing assistance.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation hereby requests Congress
13 to appropriate a total of \$1,254,200,000.00 for Indian Housing.

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation hereby requests that the ACT of 1996,
15 P.L. 104-330, be amended to include:

- 16 1. Authorization for the Secretary to waive environmental assessment requirements
17 that do not affect environmental health or safety of the community.
18 2. Authorization for the Secretary to waive local cooperation agreement
19 requirements.

20 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 01ST day
21 of APRIL, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,253.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;
22 164.0 NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (j)
23 of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham
24 Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs
25 (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




