2		States Department of Interior, Bureau of Reclamation (BOR), Phoenix Area office
3		under the Indian Self Determination and Education Assistance Act, Public Law 93-
4		638, for the purpose of conducting a comprehensive water inventory of the Nation,
5		designated as Agreement No. 98-FG-32-00800 (Grant Agreement); and
6	WHEREAS,	the term of the Grant Agreement has been extended for one (1) year beginning on
7		October 1, 2001 and expiring on September 30, 2002 and Budget justification was
8		authorized under Resolution No. 01-516; and
9	WHEREAS,	the Water Resources Study program has proposed a budget amendment for the
10		remainder of fiscal year 2002 in the amount of \$2,006,747.70, but used incorrect
11		number in the baseline column of the "budget amendment summary"; and
12	WHEREAS,	the Water Resources Study program has proposed a budget amendment for the
13		remainder of fiscal year 2002 in the amount of \$2,172,740.75.
14	WHEREAS,	it is necessary for the Water Resources Study Program to add the following budget
15		lines to the budget amendment: 614, Seasonal Labor, 813 Consultants, and 819
16		Consultants' expense; and
17	WHEREAS,	this budget amendment has been reviewed by the Water Resources Committee and
18		the Budget and Finance Committee and its recommended for approval by the
19		Legislative Council.
20	NOW, THER	EFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby rescinds
21		Budget Amendment approved by Resolution 01-654 in its entirety.

23		of savings of Bureau of Reclamation funds provided by the P.L. 93-638 Bureau of
24		Reclamation Grant, for the Water Resources Study Program in the total amount of
