7		agreement the Bureau of Reclamation has agreed to fund the construction of certain
8		projects to complete the Schuk Toak New Farm construction, including but not
9		limited to a farm maintenance building, a farm access road, and a chemical storage
10		building (the "Projects'); and
11	WHEREAS,	the Nation's Water Projects Office requires the services of a construction inspector
12		during the construction of the Projects to ensure the quality of the contracted
13		construction work; and
14	WHEREAS,	the Bureau of Reclamation has a qualified, experienced field engineer/inspector
15		available at its Tucson office, and is willing to provide the services of Joseph Crowson
16		to the Water Projects Office as a part-time, temporary construction inspector for
17		construction of the Projects; and
18	WHEREAS,	the Nation and the Bureau of Reclamation have negotiated a Memorandum of
19		Agreement regarding the temporary assignment of Reclamation employee Joseph
20		Crowson to the Water Projects Office as a construction inspector during the
21		construction of the Projects; and
22	WHEREAS,	this Memorandum of Agreement has been reviewed by the Water Resources
23		Committee and the Agriculture Committee of the Legislative Council and is
24		recommended for approval by the full Legislative Council.
25	NOW , THEF	REFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
26		Memorandum of Agreement Between the Tohono O'odham Nation and the Bureau
