

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Setting April 13, 2002 Special Session at Tohono O'odham High School to Address
Remaining Public Forum Issues)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 02-175

1 **WHEREAS, on March 22, 2002, the Legislative Council Rules Committee did receive a letter from**
2 **San Lucy District Chairwoman Ernestine Marquez, who, on behalf of the Tohono**
3 **O'odham Nation District Chairpersons, requested that the Legislative Council hold**
4 **a public forum; and**

5 **WHEREAS, seven Tohono O'odham Nation District Councils have passed resolutions supporting**
6 **the public forum request; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham District Chairpersons and seven District Councils have**
8 **requested a public forum regarding the following issues, which were not addressed**
9 **during the April 5, 2002 General Session and public forum due to time constraints:**

- 10 **I. Financial Status: (A) Salary Wage Increase**
11 **(B) Gaming Revenues/Savings**
12 **II. Pending Projects: (A) Nursing Home Facility**
13 **(B) Westside Health Center**
14 **(C) Dialysis Center**
15 **(D) Radio Station**
16 **III. Housing: ICDBG**

17 **WHEREAS, it has been requested that an additional public forum addressing these remaining**
18 **issues be held at Tohono O'odham High School on April 13, 2002; and**

19 **WHEREAS, according to the Legislative Rules, Article I, Section 2.C, "PLACE," Subsection 1.B, "A**
20 **majority of all the Legislative Representatives may agree to hold a Session in some**
21 **location other than the Chambers located at Sells. Such agreement may be by written**
22 **petition or by motion at any Legislative Session or the Legislative Council."**

23 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**
24 **sets a Special Session for April 13, 2002, which shall be held at the Tohono O'odham**
25 **High School.**

26 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Special Session's purpose shall be to hold a public forum**
27 **addressing the above-identified issues, which shall be the only items on the agenda.**

29 **The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 05TH Day of**
30 **APRIL 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,771.85 FOR; 645.65**
31 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**


