

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving Tohono O'odham Utility Authority Greater Santa Rosa Regional**  
**Water System Right-of-Way, Gu Achi District, Sif Oidak District, Tohono**  
**O'odham Nation)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 02-197**

1 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 08-70 the Nation established the Papago Tribal Utility Authority,**  
2 **now known as Tohono O'odham Utility Authority (TOUA) for purposes of constructing,**  
3 **maintaining and operating various utility systems within the Nation to be owned**  
4 **wholly by the Nation; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on 10 December 1990 did pass Resolution**  
6 **No. 447-90 (Amending the Restated Plan of Operation of the Tohono O'odham Utility**  
7 **Authority) and Resolution No. 91-175 (Adopting Second Restated Plan of Operation for**  
8 **the Tohono O'odham Utility Authority) which requires the Authority to submit for**  
9 **prior review and approval of the Legislative Council and each affected District any**  
10 **proposed utility easement; and**

11 **WHEREAS, TOUA requests permission for a Right-of-Way to construct the Greater Santa Rosa**  
12 **Regional Water System and other utilities/related facilities for the communities of**  
13 **Anegam, North Komelik, North Santa Rosa, Palo Verde Stand, San Luis, Santa Rosa,**  
14 **and Santa Rosa Boarding School, Gu Achi District, Sif Oidak District, Tohono O'odham**  
15 **Nation; and**

16 **WHEREAS the communities served by the Greater Santa Rosa Regional Water System will receive**  
17 **the benefits of a reliable water source, greater water storage, increased and**  
18 **stabilized water pressure, and better water quality; and**

19 **WHEREAS, TOUA has respectfully submitted all documents and pertinent information (attached**  
20 **hereto and incorporated herein by reference) for uses consistent with the authorized**  
21 **purposes of TOUA; and**

22 **WHEREAS, the Greater Santa Rosa Regional Water System and other utilities/related facilities**  
23 **will be of substantial benefit to the communities served, Gu Achi District, Sif Oidak**  
24 **District, the Tohono O'odham Nation and their respective members; and**

25 **WHEREAS, the Gu Achi District Council approved to develop and construct the project on 09**  
26 **September 2000 by its Resolution No. 0900-250 which was amended on 07 November**  
27 **2001 by Resolution No. 1101-293; and**

28 **WHEREAS, the Sif Oidak District Council approved that portion known as the North Komelik**  
29 **Inter-tie Water System on 05 December 2001 by its Resolution No. 12-01-01; and**



1 **WHEREAS, the Natural Resources Committee has reviewed TOUA's request on 03 May 2002 and**  
2 **by consensus does recommend approval thereof by the Tohono O'odham Legislative**  
3 **Council.**

4 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby**  
5 **approve the Right-of-Way as requested by TOUA for the Greater Santa Rosa Regional**  
6 **Water System and other utilities/related facilities in the location (as more fully**  
7 **described in the attached map and legal description) and construction by TOUA or its**  
8 **designated subsidiaries for uses consistent with the authorized purposes of TOUA.**

9 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 07<sup>th</sup>, Day**  
10 **of MAY 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**  
11 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (c)(2)**  
12 **and (i)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
13 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
14 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
15 **Stat. 984).**
