(Extension of FY 2001 Community Oriented Policing Services Tribal Resources
Grant Program Funding to September 30, 2002 - Law Enforcement)**

RESOLUTION NO. 02-198

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department was awarded a Community Oriented**
2 **Policing Services Tribal Resources Grant Program funding through the Department**
3 **of Justice in the amount of \$338,925.00; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council in fiscal year 2001 passed Resolution No.**
5 **01-015 to accept and expend these grant funds in accordance with the budget**
6 **attached; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the grant is to be used specifically for equipment and training; and**

8 **WHEREAS, a request to extend the award period of this grant to November 30, 2002 was granted**
9 **by the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Community Oriented Policing Services;**
10 **and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department is requesting to extend the original**
12 **budget to September 30, 2002 to reflect the extended grant award period.**

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the attached budget, in the amount of \$338,925.00 for**
14 **the Community Oriented Policing Services Tribal Resources Grant Program, is hereby**
15 **extended to September 30, 2002.**

16 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the award period for the Community Oriented Policing Services**
17 **Tribal Resources Grant Program expires on November 30, 2002.**

18 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 07th Day**
19 **of MAY 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
20 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of**
21 **Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**
22 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
23 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**




