15		men and women; and						
16	WHEREAS,	there is a need for a veterans uniform to identify them as Veterans and to properly						
17		honor our military and provide military services; and						
18	WHEREAS,	we are modifying the existing Tohono O'odham Veterans Affairs Office tribal budget						
19		to include line item 723 - oversea caps and uniforms.
