

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Amending Legislative Order No. 01-040, "Adopting 'Judicial Appointment Procedure'")**

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 02-207

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to appoint judges**
2 **to the Tohono O'odham Judicial Court pursuant to Section 3 of Article VIII of the**
3 **Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, ("Constitution") which states, "The**
4 **Tohono O'odham Courts shall be courts of record and shall consist of at least six (6)**
5 **judges appointed by the Tohono O'odham Council."; and**

6 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Legislative Order No. 01-040, the Legislative Council did adopt a Judicial**
7 **Appointment Procedure to govern the process for appointing Tohono O'odham**
8 **Judicial Court judges; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Judiciary Committee now recommends that the Judicial Appointment Procedure**
10 **be amended to remove the Judicial Court Administrator's role in advertising**
11 **vacancies, accepting applications, and receiving notice of appointments; and**


12 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council has reviewed the attached, amended Judicial Appointment**
13 **Procedure, which is hereby incorporated by this reference.**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
15 **amends Legislative Order No. 01-040 to adopt the amended Judicial Appointment**
16 **Procedure.**


17 **BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that the amended Judicial Appointment Procedure shall become**
18 **effective immediately and shall govern the Legislative Council's process for**
19 **appointing judges to the Tohono O'odham Judicial Court.**

20 **The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 09TH Day of**
21 **MAY, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0-**
22 **NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (a) of**
23 **Article VI and Section 3 of Article VIII of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted**
24 **by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
25 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
26 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
