4		Tohono O'odham Courts shall be courts of record and shall consist of at least six (6)
5		judges appointed by the Tohono O'odham Council."; and
6	WHEREAS,	pursuant to Legislative Order No. 01-040, the Legislative Council did adopt a Judicial
7		Appointment Procedure to govern the process for appointing Tohono O'odham
8		Judicial Court judges; and
9	WHEREAS,	the Judiciary Committee now recommends that the Judicial Appointment Procedure
10		be amended to remove the Judicial Court Administrator's role in advertising
11		vacancies, accepting applications, and receiving notice of appointments; and
12	WHEREAS,	the Legislative Council has reviewed the attached, amended Judicial Appointment
13		Procedure, which is hereby incorporated by this reference.
14	now, ther	EFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby
15		amends Legislative Order No. 01-040 to adopt the amended Judicial Appointment
16		Procedure.
17	BE IT FURT	THER ORDERED that the amended Judicial Appointment Procedure shall become
18		effective immediately and shall govern the Legislative Council's process for
19		appointing judges to the Tohono O'odham Judicial Court.
