RESOLUTION NO. 02-209

1 **WHEREAS, the funding amount for the State of Arizona, Department of Economic Security - PY**
2 **2001 Youth Program was originally budgeted at \$133,714.00; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the final allocation increases this budget a total of \$3,999.00 to increase budget to**
4 **\$137,713.00; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the indirect cost decreased effective 10/01/01 from 17.4% to 14.3%; and**

6 **WHEREAS, this budget is designed to provide training and support services to eligible Tohono**
7 **O'odham members residing on the Tohono O'odham Nation.**

8 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby**
9 **approve the State of Arizona - Department of Economic Security - PY 2001 Youth**
10 **Program Budget Modification #1 and Contract Amendment #1 in the amount of**
11 **\$137,713.00.00.**

12 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
13 **Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute**
14 **the contract, provided however, that any amendment affecting the funding or funding**
15 **levels of this contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.**

16 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 09TH Day**
17 **of MAY, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,184.55 FOR; 232.95**
18 **AGAINST;-0- NOT VOTING; and [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section**
19 **1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
20 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
21 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
22 **Stat. 984).**


