

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approval of the Employment & Training Program PY 02/FY 03 Budgets/Comprehensive Service Plan/State Contracts)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 02-210**

1 **WHEREAS, the Department of Labor - Comprehensive Service Plan and Budget has been**  
2 **developed with current allocation in the amount of \$473,409.00 beginning July 1, 2002**  
3 **and ending June 30, 2005; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Department of Labor - Supplemental Youth Service Plan and Budget has been**  
5 **developed with current allocation in the amount of \$172,404.00 beginning June 1,**  
6 **2002 and ending June 30, 2005; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Economic Security - Adult and Youth PY 02 and FY 03**  
8 **Budgets and Contracts have been developed with current allocation in the amount**  
9 **of \$259,979.00; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services budget has been developed in the**  
11 **amount of \$150,868.00 beginning July 1, 2002 and ending June 30, 2003.**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby**  
13 **approve the Employment & Training Budgets/Comprehensive Service Plan and**  
14 **Budget PY 2002 in the amount of \$645,813.00 Department of Health and Human**  
15 **Services Native Employment Works Budget PY 2002 in the amount of \$150,868.00 and**  
16 **Arizona Department of Economic Security State Contracts PY 02/FY 03 in the amount**  
17 **of \$259,979.00 in the combined amount of \$1,056,660.00 and authorized to incur**  
18 **expenditures upon approval of this resolution.**

19 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**  
20 **Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute**  
21 **the contracts and plans, provided however, that any amendment affecting the**  
22 **funding or funding levels of this contract shall be submitted for further prior**  
23 **approval by this Council**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 09<sup>TH</sup>. Day**  
26 **of MAY, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,184.55 FOR; 160.7**  
27 **AGAINST; 72.25 NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
28 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
29 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
30 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
31 **Stat. 984).**




