

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Acknowledging Results of May 4, 2002 Special Recall Election of Hickiwan District  
Council, Schuschukigk Community Alternate Lenora Montana)**

RESOLUTION NO. 02-215

1 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 02-164, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council set May**  
2 **4, 2002 as the date for holding the special recall election for Hickiwan District**  
3 **Council, Schuschukigk Community Alternate Lenora Montana; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the special recall election was conducted by the Election Board on May 4, 2002; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Election Board has certified (1) that more than thirty percent (30%) of the eligible**  
6 **voters registered to vote for such office voted in the recall election, and (2) that the**  
7 **incumbent received seven (7) of the twenty-seven (27) votes cast; and**

8 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Article X, Section 16(A) and (C) of the Uniform Election Ordinance, an**  
9 **incumbent who receives less than a majority of the votes cast in a special recall**  
10 **election "shall continue to perform the duties of [her] office until the Certificate of**  
11 **Election Results has been officially posted and [her] successor has been certified and**  
12 **seated."**

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council**

14 **that it hereby accepts the Election Board's Certificate of Election Results in the**  
15 **special recall election regarding Petitions #REC-H-02-02, and acknowledges that**  
16 **Petition #REC-H-02-02 has passed.**

17 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that, as the incumbent**  
18 **Hickiwan District Council, Schuschukigk Community Alternate Lenora Montana,**  
19 **received less than a majority of the votes cast in the Special Recall Election, she**  
20 **"shall continue to perform the duties of [her] office until the Certificate of Election**  
21 **Results has been officially posted and [her] successor has been certified and seated"**  
22 **(Article X, Section 16(C) of the Uniform Election Ordinance).**

23 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
24 **of MAY, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,273.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**  
25 **144.5 NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (g)**  
26 **of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**  
27 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**  
28 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**

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




