

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FEMA Grant for purchase of Tender Truck for the Tohono O'odham Nation Fire
Department, Wildland Fire Management Division)**

RESOLUTION NO. 02-229

1 **WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety/Tohono O'odham Nation Fire Department has taken**
2 **over Operations of the P.L. 93-638, Wildland Management program from the Bureau**
3 **of Indian Affairs to provide fire suppression, prevention and the emergency**
4 **protection of natural and cultural resources and wildlife on the Tohono O'odham**
5 **Nation; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation"), in exercise of its sovereign authority, desires**
7 **to manage and regulate the acquisition of additional equipment necessary to provide**
8 **adequate fire protection to the members of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the FEMA Grant awarded \$158,400.00 for the TONFD to assist with fire protection and**
10 **safety with a required 10% matching fund of \$17,600.**

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
12 **FEMA Grant funds at \$ 158,400.00.**

13 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the FY 2002 Wildland Fire Management Division P.L. 93-638**
14 **budget funds in the amount \$17,600.00 will be used as the Nation's 10% match, as**
15 **allowed by P.L. 93-638, Section 106 (j).**

16 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10TH Day**
17 **of MAY, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,256.8 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
18 **160.7 NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f)**
19 **of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**
20 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
21 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**






