

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Filing Analysis and Arguments Regarding Initiative Measure, "Tohono O'odham Nation
Members in Support of the Sun Rise Hill Site for the Cultural Center Museum")**

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 02-237

1 **WHEREAS, Article VI, Section 1(g) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the**
2 **Legislative Council with authority "to enact laws and ordinances for conducting and**
3 **regulating elections"; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council did enact the Uniform Election Ordinance ("Election**
5 **Ordinance"), Ordinance No. 03-86, which identifies the role of the Legislative Council**
6 **in the initiative process; and**

7 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Article XII of the Election Ordinance, the Election Board has certified that**
8 **Initiative Petition No. IN-01-02, "Tohono O'odham Nation Members in Support of the**
9 **Sun Rise Hill Site for the Cultural Center Museum" ("Initiative") has received a**
10 **minimum of three hundred valid signatures; and**

11 **WHEREAS, based upon the Election Board's certification, the Legislative Council has called a**
12 **special election for July 27, 2002 to allow the Nation's voter to consider the Initiative;**
13 **and**

14 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Article XII, Section 11(B), of the Election Ordinance,**
15 **"Not later than sixty (60) days preceding the election the council, after providing**
16 **reasonable opportunity for comments by all representatives, shall prepare and file**
17 **with the Election Board an analysis of the provisions of each ballot proposal of a**
18 **measure together with a list of popular arguments favoring and opposing each**
19 **proposal. Each argument, favoring and opposing each such proposal shall not exceed**
20 **three hundred (300) words in length"; and**

21 **WHEREAS, Legislative Council representatives were given a reasonable opportunity to comment;**
22 **and**

23 **WHEREAS, the Rules Committee, in cooperation with the Legislative Chairwoman and Vice**
24 **Chairman, has developed the attached analysis of and arguments for and against the**
25 **Initiative, which are hereby incorporated by this reference; and**

26 **WHEREAS, the Council's preparation and filing of the attached analysis and arguments as**
27 **mandated by the Election Ordinance does not constitute support for or opposition to**
28 **the Sun Rise Hill site.**



1 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby directs**
2 **the Legislative Secretary to file the attached analysis and arguments pertaining to**
3 **Initiative No. IN-01-02 with the Election Board no later than May 28, 2002 as required**
4 **pursuant to Article XII, Section 11(B), of the Election Ordinance.**

5 **The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 24TH Day of**
6 **MAY, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,213.1 FOR; 204.4 AGAINST;**
7 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (g) of**
8 **Article VI and Article XV of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
9 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
10 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
11 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
