

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the Tohono O'odham Nation's participation with the National Congress
of American Indians (NCAI) effort to lobby the United States Congress to continue
funding the Special Diabetes Programs for Indians beyond FY 2003)

RESOLUTION NO. 02-245

1 **WHEREAS, in the 1997 Balanced Budget Act (P. L. 105-33), the United States Congress created the**
2 **Special Diabetes Programs for Indians (SDPI), mandating funding of \$30 million**
3 **annually via grant programs designed to prevent and treat diabetes in Indian**
4 **Country through fiscal year 2002; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council, through Resolution 98-149, approved the**
6 **Community Based Diabetes Prevention Program, the Tohono O'odham Nation's SDPI**
7 **program administered through the Tohono O'odham Department of Human Services;**
8 **and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council, through Resolution No. 2000-182, renamed**
10 **the Community Based Diabetes Prevention Program to the Healthy O'odham**
11 **Promotion Program (HOPP); and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham provides diabetes prevention services by way of the Healthy**
13 **O'odham Promotion Program (HOPP) by providing and facilitating behavior**
14 **modification through fitness and nutrition education via community workshops and**
15 **fitness centers funded exclusively by the SDPI; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the HOPP fitness centers, established by SDPI funding are experiencing successful**
17 **attendance by community members; and**

18 **WHEREAS, for HOPP to succeed in its mission to prevent diabetes, additional funds are required**
19 **to continue building infrastructure and training staff to change the health behavior**
20 **of at least one generation of the Tohono O'odham in order to incorporate a diabetes**
21 **risk prevention lifestyle; and**

22 **WHEREAS, continuing the SDPI beyond FY 2003 would greatly benefit the Tohono O'odham**
23 **Nation's efforts through the HOPP in preventing diabetes.**

24 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

- 25 **1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby requests that the U. S. Congress**
26 **continue funding the Special Diabetes Programs for Indians beyond FY 2003; and**
27 **2. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby provides its support to the**
28 **National Congress of American Indians in its effort to lobby the U. S. Congress to**
29 **continue funding the Special Diabetes Programs for Indians beyond FY 2003.**
