17	WHEREAS,	on two occasions Senator Richardson was the original sponsor of legislation that
18		helped facilitate the preservation of Baboquivari Peak on the national level; and
19	WHEREAS,	domestic violence is of grave concern to the Tohono O'odham Nation and the Tohono C'odham C'od
20		O'odham Legislative Council recognizes Senator Richardson is widely regarded as a
21		leading advocate on domestic violence issues in the State of Arizona. By passing
22		numerous bills on this issue into law, she has literally brought this issue to the
23		forefront in the State of Arizona; and
