

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Amendment Department of Human Services/Division of Child Welfare Services -
FY 2002 Title IV-B Child Welfare Service Subpart 1 and Promoting Safe and
Stable Families, Subpart 2, Social Security Act)

RESOLUTION NO. 02-255

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has always had a desire to provide for the health and**
2 **welfare needs of O'odham children and families; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved the re-application of the**
4 **Department of Human Services/Division of Child Welfare Services - FY 2002 Title IV-B**
5 **Child Welfare Services Subpart 1 estimated funding amount of \$44,768 in Resolution**
6 **No. 01-640 and the Promoting Safe and Stable Families, Subpart 2, estimated funding**
7 **amount \$41,298 in Resolution No. 01-641; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the application funding amount was based on the previous year's funding; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the final allocations for the Department of Human Services/Administration has**
10 **granted FY 2002 for Children and Families/Administration on Children, Youth and**
11 **Families in the amount of:**

12 **1. Title IV-B, Subpart 1 - Child Welfare Services \$43,721**

13 **2. Title IV-B, Subpart 2 - Promoting Safe and Stable Families - \$39,727**

14 **WHEREAS, the second year budget for Title IV-B, Subpart 1 Child Welfare Services and Subpart**
15 **2 Promoting Safe and Stable Families are hereby amended to reflect the final**
16 **allocated amounts stated for each program.**

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that:**

18 **1. It hereby approves the amendment of the budgets for Title IV-B Subpart 1 Child**
19 **Welfare Service to \$43,721 and Subpart 2 Promoting Safe & Stable Families to**
20 **\$39,727 to reflect the final allocations.**

21 **2. That the Tohono O'odham Nation, to wit: the Chairman is hereby authorized to**
22 **negotiate and execute the budget.**

23 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 04TH. Day**
24 **of JUNE, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
25 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of**
26 **Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**
27 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
28 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
