

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of FY 2003 Division of Community Health Services/Tuberculosis Control
Services Program Budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 02-257

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has operated the Tuberculosis Control Services**
2 **Program to help prevent the spread of the disease through community education,**
3 **prevention, early detection, comprehensive regimens and careful follow up with**
4 **individuals; and**

5 **WHEREAS, funding for the operation of the Tohono O'odham Tuberculosis Control Services**
6 **Program has been provided in part through supplemental funding sources; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Division of Community Health Services - Tuberculosis Control Services desires to**
8 **continue the services it provides to TB susceptible patients; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Tuberculosis Control Services Program has received funding**
10 **from the State of Arizona, Department of Health Services for its program; and**

11 **WHEREAS, a budget in the amount of \$22,374.09 is submitted for review and approval by the**
12 **Department of Human Services, Division of Community Health to utilize funds to**
13 **continue the services it provides.**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that:**

- 15 **1. It hereby approves the proposal for funding of the Tohono O'odham Tuberculosis**
16 **Control Services Program from the State of Arizona Department of Health**
17 **Services and approves expenditures in accordance with the attached budget in**
18 **the amount of \$22,374.09.**
- 19 **2. The duration of this contract shall be from July 01, 2002 and remain in effect as**
20 **long as the Arizona Department of Health Services agrees to fund the Tohono**
21 **O'odham Tuberculosis Control Services Program.**
- 22 **3. The Tohono O'odham Nation Officials, to wit: the Chairman, and Vice Chairman**
23 **and any designated Official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute this**
24 **contract.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 04TH Day**
27 **of JUNE, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
28 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (h) of**
29 **Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**
30 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
31 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
