2		Prevention and Control Service Program to provide HIV/STD prevention education
3		to communities and schools; and
4	WHEREAS,	funding for the prevention education has been provided by the State of Arizona
5		Department of Health Services; and
6	WHEREAS,	the  Tohono O'odham Nation has entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement with
7		the State of Arizona Department of Health Services to fund and operate the HIV
8		Prevention and Control Services Program through December 30, 2003; and
9	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation desires to continue to provide HIV/STD prevention
10		education to communities and schools; and
11	WHEREAS,	a budget in the amount of \$6,411.96 is submitted for review and approval by the
12		Department of Human Services, Division of Community Health to utilize funds for
13		prevention education.
14	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that:
15		1. It hereby approves the proposal for funding of the HIV Prevention and Control
16		Services from the State of Arizona Department of Health Services and approves
17		expenditures in accordance with the attached budget in the amount of \$6,411.96.
18		2. The Tohono O'odham Nation Officials, to wit: the Chairman is hereby authorized
19		to negotiate and execute this contract and to expend funds when received.
