

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approval of FY 2002 Community Health Services/HIV Prevention and Control**  
**Services Budget)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 02-259**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has operated the Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV)**  
2 **Prevention and Control Service Program to provide HIV/STD prevention education**  
3 **to communities and schools; and**

4 **WHEREAS, funding for the prevention education has been provided by the State of Arizona**  
5 **Department of Health Services for HIV Prevention and Counseling; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement with**  
7 **the State of Arizona Department of Health Services to continue to fund and operate**  
8 **the HIV Prevention and Control Services Program, which commenced on January 01,**  
9 **2001 through December 30, 2003; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation does desire to continue to provide HIV/STD prevention**  
11 **education to communities and schools; and**

12 **WHEREAS, a budget in the amount of \$6,411.96 is submitted for review and approval by the**  
13 **Department of Human Services, Division of Community Health to utilize funds for**  
14 **prevention education.**


15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that:**

- 16           **1. It hereby approves the funding of the HIV Prevention and Control Services**  
17           **Program from the State of Arizona Department of Health Services and approves**  
18           **expenditures in accordance with the attached budget in the amount of \$6,411.96.**  
19           **2. The Tohono O'odham Nation Officials, to wit: the Chairman is hereby authorized**  
20           **to negotiate and execute this contract and to expend funds when received.**

21 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 04<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
22 **of JUNE, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,250.2 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**  
23 **-0- NOT VOTING; and 167.3 [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section**  
24 **1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
25 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
26 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
27 **Stat. 984).**

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


