

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Authorizing Tohono O'odham Nation Delegation to the National Congress of
American Indians' 2002 Mid-Year Session)

RESOLUTION NO. 02-263

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to consult with**
2 **other Indian tribes on all matters within the Council's authority (Constitution of the**
3 **Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(f); and**

4 **WHEREAS, the National Congress of American Indians (NCAI) will hold its 2002 Mid-Year Session**
5 **in Bismark, North Dakota from June 16-19, 2002; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has worked closely with the NCAI and with Indian tribes**
7 **across the United States to respond to the proposed Department of the Interior**
8 **reorganization, advocate for improved Indian health care, analyze trust reform**
9 **proposals, develop legislative responses to United States Supreme Court opinions**
10 **which threaten tribal sovereignty, and address numerous other national issues of**
11 **importance to Indian people; and**

12 **WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the Tohono O'odham Nation to continue its national-level**
13 **involvement in these issues by participating in the NCAI 2002 Mid-Year Session.**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
15 **authorizes the following representatives to attend and serve as the Tohono O'odham**
16 **Nation's delegation to the National Congress of American Indians 2002 Mid-Year**

26 **alternate voting delegate to the National Congress of American Indians' 2002 Mid-**



The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 04TH Day of JUNE, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,323.35 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 94.15 NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


